

### What are your thoughts on the current arts landscape as a whole?

Since my family and I came back from Asia to Houston in 2000, I have seen the art scene get much more international and stronger. The city has also realized that it has an art history worth honoring and recognizing, especially in the past five years. As we grow in prominence as a major art city, this will become more and more important in telling our story.

#### What are you loving in the art world this year?

I am loving the emphasis on Black artists, and we have several that we have been featuring. Our current exhibitions (Houston Foundations) feature both Bert L. Long Jr. and Jesse Lott. Our February-to-April exhibition features Angelbert Metoyer. All of these artists' works are outstanding.
