
The Fun Develops Instantly

The influential '80s artist/fashion designer/filmmaker Maripol is known for her candid Polaroid snaps of New York's underground art scene. She photographed Deborah Harry, Grace Jones, Andy Warhol, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Patti Astor and Madonna. The exhibit "Maripolarama: Perverse City" features some of these photos — blown up to larger sizes — which reveal the party lifestyle of the era's artistic set.



Also featured in the show are a handful of Maripol's larger, black-and-white Polaroids from her *Address Book* series. The photos feature recent, lesser-known faces from today's world of entertainment.
