Jay Rusovich was born in New Orleans and has received degrees from Tulane University in English and Theater, and also attended Oxford University in England, The University of Arizona and Loyola University in New Orleans. After graduating, he moved to New York City where he studied Method Acting at The Lee Strasberg Institute. Rusovich also attended The Actor's Institute for Shakespearean Studies and TVI Actors Studio in NYC.
